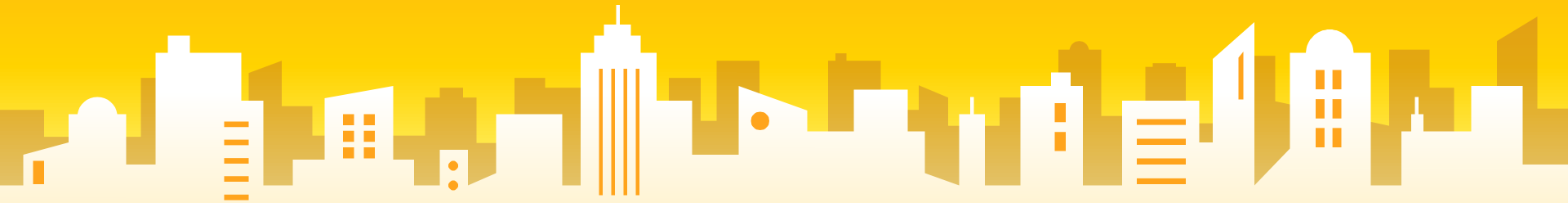

Reading Data from different countries

- Australia/UK will have a total IB score that you need to meet in order to be considered
- Canada will have total IB score that is their minimum
- US looks at grades and courses not total IB points
- Also consider program selectivity

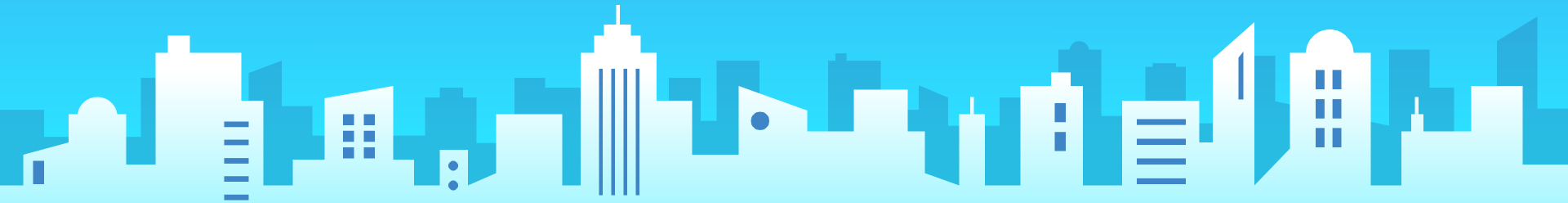

Teacher Recommendation Letters

- ❑ Students ask two teachers (for US -everyone else one)
- ❑ Fill out Resume form to give to teachers, or fill out their own resumes
- ❑ Agreement form/Resume hand-in April 5th
- ❑ SFS teachers agree to write only “favorable letters” that help student gains admission to university
- ❑ All letters are confidential
- ❑ You can choose a teacher who is leaving

Other important deadlines

- **May 15th - Junior Survey** - this is what your counselor will rely heavily on to write your recommendation letter
- **May 15th - Parent Brag Sheet** - they know you best! This also helps counselors write your letter.

Overheard at SFS

- ❖ The more selective a college is, the better it must be
- ❖ If a university is “easy” to get into, it can’t be any good
- ❖ The “best” students are applying to the US/UK, therefore, so should I
- ❖ I need to skip class service/ sport/activity in order to do my university applications
- ❖ If I make the “wrong” choice now, my future/ career/life will be over
- ❖ Only students who attend the most famous universities have jobs/are financially secure/are happy /lead fulfilling lives
